Teenage Young Parent LAC

Clinical pathway may also be in place dependent on identified concerns with the pregnancy

**Universal to L4**  
 Midwife completes Teenage Pregnancy Multi-agency and Health Visitor Information Form at antenatal booking.  
 Forms to be shared with CCS 0-19 teams  
 Client signature on form for agreement to work with other agencies

LAC TYP placed in area and not booked in with a local midwife

LAC TYP placed out of area  
 Social Care to contact relevant LA public health team (Local Public Health Team will support with this)

Social Care to support midwifery booking appointment for TYP

**LAC**  
 Midwife to notify safeguarding midwife MASH/Social Worker (if TYP has not already done so), and LAC Nurse of pregnancy.

Sexual Health and Contraception advice and support (Sexual Health Service, Midwives and Health Visitors.  
 All professionals to be aware of PNMH signs and signpost as appropriate

**Complex needs or additional vulnerabilities identified -**

- Referral to the Family Partnership Service
- Referral for safeguarding concerns

All services accessed via the Luton Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub

**Monthly Overview Meeting**  
 Time and venue: Tokko (usually the first Wednesday of each month) meeting arranged by Youth Project Manager & Young Mums Specialist  
 (all professionals to bring case information to the meeting)  
**Attendees to include:** Teenage Caseload Manager/Midwife, Youth Project Manager & Young Mums Specialist, Starting Well Midwife, Health Visitor/0-19 Practitioner, Family Partnership Service Family Support Worker.  
 Services that can be offered to be agreed and discussed with the Teenage Young Parent  
**Information to be recorded on SystemOne following the meeting by 0-19 service**

At each stage Professionals to assess any Safeguarding concerns and refer as appropriate

28—32 weeks universal antenatal home visit completed by Health Visitor
